- 1. One Entry per exhibitor.
- 2. Open to both wethers and ewes.
- 3. All 4-H entries must be tagged as a 4-H project, and a project record book (market lamb) kept.
- 4. Lambs to be shorn just prior to Provincial Winter Fair.
- 5. All entries will be slaughtered as arranged for by the Provincial Winter Fair Committee.
- 6. Each carcass will be appraised by officers of the Livestock Division for points allocated for carcass quality.
- 7. ALL CARCASSES MUST BE SOLD THROUGH SALE and will be charged 6% commission.
- 8. All carcass lambs must be in the barn by 5:00 PM on the Thursday of the Fair, but an earlier weigh in would enable lambs to be shipped to the slaughterhouse earlier.
- 9. **4-H Entry forms**, accompanied by \$40, plus GST, must be received by **JUNE 30**. **Open Entry** forms, accompanied by \$40, plus GST, must be received by **JULY 31**. Open Post entries will be accepted at the PWF office up to **AUGUST 31**. Post entry fee is \$25.00 (non taxable), plus the regular entry fees and applicable taxes.
- 10. All exhibitors are subject to a \$5.00, plus GST, exhibitor's fee (unless paid with another registration).
- 11. All entrants in this division are subject to the General Rules & Regulations of the PWF, as well as the 4-H & OPEN Sheep Rules & Regulations.
- 12. The top 4 placed carcasses in each class, 4-H & Open, only, will return to the Fair for display. Prize money will be awarded to top four carcasses in each Division during the Group Competitions on the Saturday Evening of the Fair.
- 13. All Carcass Lambs will be stalled together until shipment to the Processing Plant
- 14. <u>It is requested that each entry supply a photograph of their carcass animal for display on Carcass Cooler and for the Sale Powerpoint.</u> (Please E-mail a JPEG file or Mail a Physical Photo)

SALE RULES

- 1. Carcasses will be sold by the dollar.
- 2. Six percent (6%) on the amount of the sale of each carcass sold will be retained by the PWF to assist in meeting general expenses.
- 3. Carcasses to be sold in blocks throughout the sale as per Schedule of Events of the PWF for that year.
- 4. The Exhibitor (or representative of that exhibitor) selling a carcass must be present in the sale ring, with required information which will be supplied by the Carcass Committee. If a contributor is not present and misses his or her spot on the sale sheet, they will automatically drop to the end of the sale.
